## Outline

The LIFE ASPIRE Consortium organises the annual Project Workshop #3, held jointly with Beneficiary Zadar Municipality as a webinar event, focused on Freight Distribution in Small/mid-sized Historic Towns and related Covid-19 impacts.

The webinar will last about 3 hours. Key outcomes and approach from LIFE ASPIRE project activities will be presented, targeted to stakeholders active in the field of last mile freight distribution for small and mid-sized historic and touristy towns, which are very common in Europe and are visible 'identity markers' that shape the EU.

The webinar aims to present the urban freight delivery rewarding approaches developed and demonstrated by LIFE ASPIRE Project in Lucca and Zadar and to provide some interesting insights on how Covid-19 could change, also in the long term, the behaviours of authorities, operators and the design of urban vehicle access regulations (UVARs) and controls. The workshop will also discuss the enhanced and multisectoral role of the local authorities in small/mid-sized historic and touristy towns, including future challenges and opportunities, on mobility related issues, such as e-commerce vs. retailers delivery strategies, restricted traffic zone vs. low emission zone, sustainable logistics plan vs. urban mobility plan, new forms of working vs. inner town Ho.Re.Ca. activities, etc.
